# FROM THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE

Please call the main office if your child will be absent from school due to illness or an appointment. If the main office does not receive a call from you, our automated system will call you; stating that your child is absent. When your child returns to school, please send in a note with an explanation of the absence. If we do not receive a written excuse within a few days of the absence, the automated system will call to remind you. If a written excuse is not received within five days of the absence, the absence will be coded as "unlawful."

If your child is sent home sick by the school nurse for signs of contagious illness (including but not limited to rash, fever, vomiting or diarrhea) please remember that your child must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to school. A written excuse will still need to be turned in.

It is considered excessive, if your child misses ten or more days of school. You will receive a letter explaining that a doctor's note will be required for all future absences. If a doctor's note is not provided, the absences will coded as unlawful. After several unlawful absences you will be subject but not limited to school based attendance plan, parent meetings and/or TRUANCY CITATIONS.



If your child will be absent from school due to a vacation, please complete a pre-approved trip form at least one week prior to the scheduled days off. This form is located on our district website or in the main office. Up to five days of vacation time may be approved.

# TARDY/ABSENT TIMES

- ~Your child is considered late (tardy) if he/she arrives between 8:35 and 10:35.
- ~ Your child is considered 1/2 day absent in the a.m. if he/she arrives by 1:25.
- ~ Your child considered 1/2 day absent in the p.m. if he/she leaves after 10:35.
- ~ Your child is considered absent ALL DAY if he/she arrives after 1:25.
